NIWIC if
you:**



- 1 Live in the City of Toronto
- 2 Do not have a family doctor/nurse practitioner
- 3 Do not have healthcare insurance because you are:

- In the 3-month wait period for OHIP
- Non-Status (No legal immigration status)
- A refugee claimant with pending/expired Interim Federal Health Program (IFHP) coverage
- In Toronto for temporary work, make minimum wage, and cannot afford private health insurance

use the
NIWIC if:**



- 1 Are a visitor or a student
- 2 Have current coverage under the:
 - Ontario Health Insurance Program (OHIP)
 - Interim Federal Health Program (IFHP)
 - Ontario Temporary Health Program (OTHP)
- 3 Have private health insurance
- 4 Have a family doctor/nurse practitioner/midwife
