## What can a person expect at the NIWIC?

The NIWIC is a walk-in clinic that offers confidential health care services on a first come, first served basis at no charge. Midwives are available to see pregnant women.

Our services include:

- episodic care - attention to a specific medical problem
- telephone interpretation
- referral to other health care providers and specialists, if required

Please bring a list of your medications and any medical records.

## Who can use the NIWIC?

### You can use the NIWIC if you:

- Live in the City of Toronto, and
- Do not have a family doctor, and
- Do not have healthcare insurance, for reasons including:
  - You are in the 3-month wait period for OHIP
  - You do not have legal immigration status (non-status)
  - You are in the refugee claim process or your refugee claim was rejected/suspended/ineligible
  - You moved to Toronto from another country for temporary work, make minimum wage (or less), and you cannot afford private health insurance.

### The NIWIC does not see patients who:

- Have a family doctor/nurse practitioner
- Have current coverage under the Ontario Health Insurance Program (OHIP), Interim Federal Health Program (IFHP), or Ontario Temporary Health Program (OTHP)
- Have private health insurance
- Are a visitor or a student
