The Centre envisions a future in which Toronto’s diverse communities achieve <b>health with dignity</b>.</p> <p>We are looking for a diligent, thoughtful, organized individual who is calm and solution focused to be part of the Centre’s interdisciplinary clinical team and work within a collaborative model of clinical practice, program planning, implementation and evaluation. Within the NP (RN-EC) scope of practice the selected candidate will provide leadership in clinical practice and initiatives and provide primary care to <b>systemically vulnerable populations that face multiple and complex health and social issues</b>.</p> <p>This NP role will be positioned at one of our remote sites to support accessible program service delivery during the clinical hours of operation. Through our remote site an <i>Episodic Care Pathway</i> has been developed to support temporarily housed Newcomers.</p>
